Description of the event:			
<p>Happy Feet is 100 minutes (1 hour 40) of dance consisting of an immersive dance event open to the public/audience. Hosted by a DJ, with a dance leader and assisted by two of The Ragroof Players, to assist. Multiple costumes are taken on and off during the show as we wiz through the era's.</p> <p>Ragroof can offer various options:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Option A: the basic package, which gives you four artists providing 30 minutes of audience gathering and dance routines influenced by 100 years of dance crazes. Followed by 60 minutes of immersive dance activity, walking the audience through 100 years of dance crazes and ending with a stick it on requests 10 minutes ● Option B: As above plus community outreach in the weeks leading up to the performance. The community then 'flash mob' Happy Feet, performing one or more sections of the piece.

Overview of Physical Production:			
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Get in, performance and get out programming must be arranged prior to arrival on site. The standard schedule comprises of get in, show and get out in the same day immediately after the show unless arranged otherwise. 			



Requirements of Presenter:

- The presenter must provide a flat, clear and clean site that will house our technical specifications.
- We will require contact details of key liaison/site manager for arrival and any other contacts needed for operating prior to arrival on site.
- Vehicle access as close to show venue as possible for unload and load plus parking for 1x transit van
- Power source – 13 amp supply run out to show site PA desk with a 4 way 13amp distribution at end. All necessary cable covering and safety requirements to be provided and installed by the presenter.
- Suitable fire safety provisions.
- Information as to first aid provisions on site.
- Dependant on venue and specific needs per booking, additional support production crew may be necessary and will need to be negotiated with each presenter.
- A secure area to store equipment and personal belongings, the venue must take responsibility for stolen or damaged property that Ragroof suffers as a result of negligence.
- Access to toilets close to the performance area.
- Meals and accommodation for all touring company members where necessary/deemed appropriate.
- 2 x volunteers / stewards to look after costumes that are set in the performance space to ensure they are not stolen.
- Lighting: a light colourful disco feel all over the dance floor as is traditional in discos. Two main areas to enhance with specials – DJ booth and dance podium.

For backstage we require the following:

- 1 x trestle table
- 4 x chairs
- 8 x sandbags/stage weights
- **If arranged for us to use your PA it must have the following:**
1 x DJ mixer, 4 channel (minimum)



- 2 x 500w speakers (minimum)
- 1 x amplifier or integrated into powered speakers
- 2 x phono inputs to plug in the DJ laptop
- 1 x radio mic
- 1 x cable mic

We strongly recommend that the venue/presenter provide:

- Refreshment facilities for audience members / tap water and plastic cups, the show is participatory and the audience work up a sweat.

- **If hired in the package Ragroof will provide ~**

- 1 x DJ mixer, 4 channel
- 2 x 500w speakers
- 2 x 400w bass bins
- 2 x 1000w amplifiers
- 1 x laptop (1 back up laptop)
- 1 x radio mic
- 1 x cable mic

Audience Profile:

- The show is accessible, suitable to all (unless specifically arranged otherwise).
- Capacity: negotiable with each presenter.

Specific details per venue may differ and will be negotiated and updated into a subsequent version pending a site visit and planning with each presenter.
